

## GPCI ACCEPTED EDUCATION POINT TRACKER

The Grant Professionals Certification Institute (GPCI) offers this form as a way for you to track the GPCI Education Points you have earned during the 2020 Grant Professionals Association (GPA) National Conference. Please note that GPCI will require you to list the title of all of the sessions you attend, not just the flat number of points for the conference. GPA is a participant in the GPCI Accepted Education Program. The Education Points you earn at this conference can be used to meet the new requirement for anyone renewing their GPC in 2021 or later. The new requirement states that at least 20% of your education points must come from GPCI Accepted Education opportunities. Participating in all of the available sessions this year will allow you to meet that new requirement!

Using this form: Enter 1.25 in the POINTS box for each full Live session you attend, and 1.25 in the POINTS box for each full On-Demand session you attend. Do not enter more than 1.25 for Live sessions or 1.25 for On-Demand sessions. Please note that the On-Demand session *Census Bureau Data for Grant Writers* is worth 0.5 points. Totals will be calculated for each and a combined Live and On-Demand CEP Total Points Attained will be calculated for you at the end of the form.
