- Summarize and report results of your reviews to the committee chair in a timely fashion.
- Validate documentation for those individuals whose packets are chosen for audit.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grant Professional Certified (GPC) credential
- Attention to detail
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to understand and comply with ethical standards and confidentiality requirements

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Average 3 hours per month
- Committee members must serve on the for at least one year to ensure compliance with accreditation.
