- Harmful or prejudicial verbal or written comments, or images, related to gender, sexual orientation, disability, race, ethnicity, religion, national origin, or other class protected by law. Such comments or images shall not be directed toward any meeting participant (as defined above), including staff members.
- Disruption of presentations during sessions through spoken or written comments. This extends to public and one-to-one chats, Q&A modules, and other areas where interaction is encouraged in the virtual event platform. We reserve the right to remove messages which detract from the learning environment.
- Presentations, postings, and messages containing promotional materials, job offers, or solicitation for services. We reserve the right to remove such messages and instances of unauthorized solicitations.
- Using AI Notetakers or recording any portion of the meeting or chat.

In response to any incident of unacceptable behavior, we reserve the right to take immediate action deemed necessary and appropriate, including immediate removal from the virtual event.
