Scholarship Application Reviewer

POSITION FUNCTION/OVERVIEW:

Each year the GPCI Board, GPA local chapters, GPA members and the Grant Professionals Foundation (GPF) provide funding for GPC scholarships. The GPC scholarship subcommittee handles the application process, reviews and scores the applications, and awards the scholarships. The scholarship subcommittee is part of GPCI's Marketing and Stakeholder Engagement Committee.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

During the scholarship cycle (usually April to July), the scholarship subcommittee chair assigns applications to committee members (reviewers), who read and score them against a rubric. The reviewers participate in a training to help guide them through this process.

New in 2024: GPCI asks that volunteers commit to serve for two or three consecutive years on the scholarship review subcommittee, in order to ensure greater consistency in the evaluation process.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A valid GPC credential
- Interest in promoting the GPC
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines
- Ability to understand and comply with ethical standards and confidentiality requirements

TIME COMMITMENT:

6 - 8 hours per year for a commitment of 2 or 3 consecutive years
